KIDSCONNECT was founded in 1996 as the Rickenbacker Area Partnership (RAP) by a broad-based collaborative of schools, local government, businesses and community organizations in southeastern Franklin County that include: Canal Winchester, Groveport Madison, Hamilton-Local and Whitehall school districts; Villages of Canal Winchester, Groveport, and Obetz; Townships of Hamilton and Madison; the Southeastern Franklin County Chamber of Commerce, and other numerous businesses and community organizations.
