Program Objectives	Outcome Measurements
Improve academic skills of students (study skills, classroom management, grades)	70% of students will increase by one letter grade in one core subject area.
Increase student inspiration for reading and writing	95% of students will maintain a writing journal. 60% of students will report an increased interest in reading.
Improve social skills (behavior-life skills)	70% of students will increase social skill mastery by 10%.
Improve citizenship	95% of students will complete a minimum of 8 community service hours between Sept-June.
Assist parents in acquiring additional skills to Help their students succeed in school.	80% of parents will attend at least one ParentConnect night throughout school year.
