| Program Objectives | Outcome Measurements |
|--|--|
| Improve academic skills of students (study skills, classroom management, grades) | 70% of students will increase by one letter grade in one core subject area. |
| Increase student inspiration for reading and writing | 95% of students will maintain a writing journal. 60% of students will report an increased interest in reading. |
| Improve social skills (behavior-life skills) | 70% of students will increase social skill mastery by 10%. |
| Increase student sense of connection to school | All students will receive weekly mentoring and tutoring from a positive adult role-model. |
