PARENTS

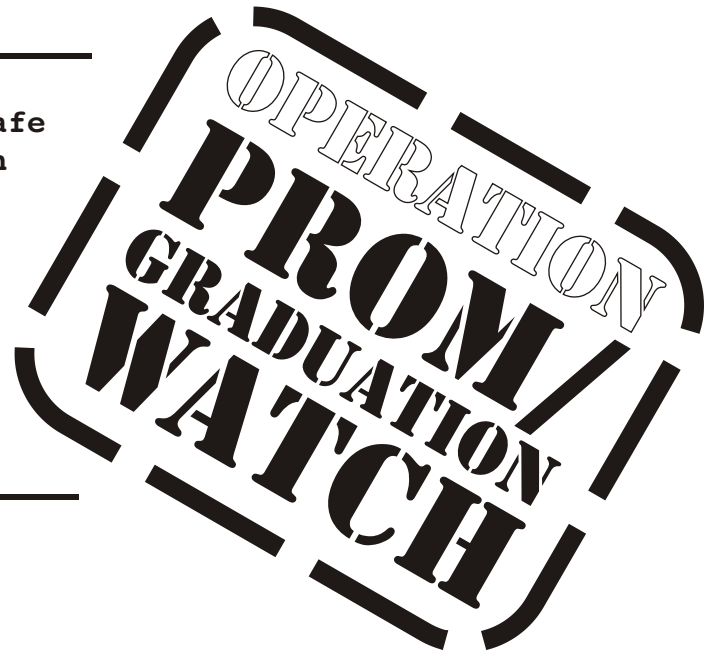
- Help your student plan an alcohol/drug-free celebration.
